Today's Scripture

2 Kings 10:28-36

28. Thus Jehu wiped out Baal from Israel.
29. But Jehu did not turn aside from the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat that he caused Israel to commit: the golden calves that were in Bethel and in Dan.
30. The Lord said to Jehu, "Because you have done well in carrying out what I consider right and in accordance with all that was in my heart have dealt with the house of Ahab, your sons of the fourth generation shall sit on the throne of Israel."
31. But Jehu was not careful to follow the law of the Lord the God of Israel with all his heart; he did not turn from the sins of Jeroboam that he caused Israel to commit.
32. In those days the Lord began to trim off parts of Israel. Hazael defeated them throughout the territory of Israel:
33. from the Jordan eastward, all the land of Gilead, the Gadites, the Reubenites, and the Manassites, from Aroer, which is by the Wadi Arnon, that is, Gilead and Bashan.
34. Now the rest of the acts of Jehu, all that he did, and all his power, are they not written in the Book of the Annals of the Kings of Israel?
35. So Jehu slept with his ancestors, and they buried him in Samaria. His son Jehoahaz succeeded him.
36. The time that Jehu reigned over Israel in Samaria was twenty-eight years.

2 Timothy 4:6-8, 16-18

6. As for me, I am already being poured out as a libation, and the time of my departure has come.
7. I have fought the good fight; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith.
8. From now on there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have longed for his appearing.
16. At my first defense no one came to my support, but all deserted me. May it not be counted against them!
17. But the Lord stood by me and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the gentiles might hear it. So I was rescued from the lion's mouth.
18. The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.
